CAMP RZR – September 22 & 23, 2017
ATV/OHRV Traffic Rules and Information

Purpose: These rules and associated information are provided to the public to promote the safety of the traveling public and all residents of the City.

The Berlin and Gorham Police Departments ask all motorists and OHRV users to operate their vehicles with caution and due care. It is anticipated that the roadways in the area will be very busy, and the following rules must be adhered to by OHRV operators:

1. OHRV's will be allowed to travel on all streets and State roads within the City of Berlin with two exceptions noted below, on **September 22 & 23, 2017 between the hours of 7 am and 10pm.**
 - a. NH State Route 16 north at the intersection of Route 16 and Cates Hill Road.
 - b. NH State Route 110 at the ATV/OHRV trailhead located across from Jericho Motorsports at 232 Jericho Road/NH Route 110.
2. OHRV's are not allowed to travel into Gorham via Route 16 south, no OHRV traffic is allowed on the Berlin/Gorham Road/NH Route 16 north of Route 2 or south of the Berlin City Limit. There are OHRV trails that connect Berlin and Gorham.
3. All motor vehicle laws must be obeyed when operating on the roadways (the same as a motorcycle, cars and trucks).
4. Local area law enforcement officials will take a "zero-tolerance" approach in enforcing all motor vehicle laws. (for example: speeding, DWI's, loud mufflers, operating recklessly, riding on one tire with "dirt bikes" and riding on two tires with "4-wheeled vehicles."). Excessive noise and speed will close access routes and trails. Follow posted signs. No exhaust modifications are permitted.
5. Riders shall not operate their vehicles side by side and must travel single file.
6. All riders shall possess a valid NH OHRV registration in accordance with NH State Statutes.
7. Riders shall follow the flow of traffic in the traffic lanes and not travel in the breakdown lane or shoulder of the roadway.
8. All Trails and Highways close to OHRV use at 10PM! Riders must be back at their destination and cannot operate after this hour, this will be strictly enforced, please make your travel plans accordingly.
